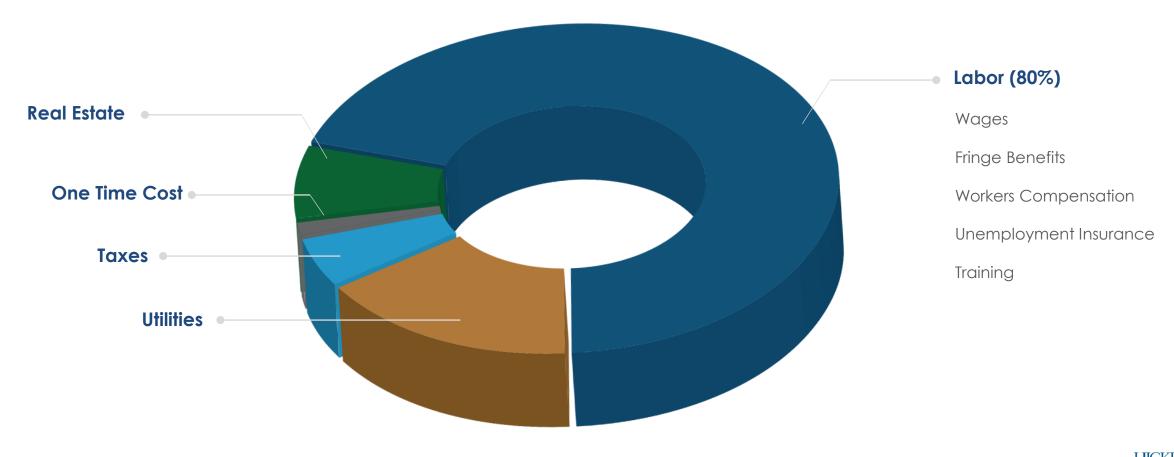

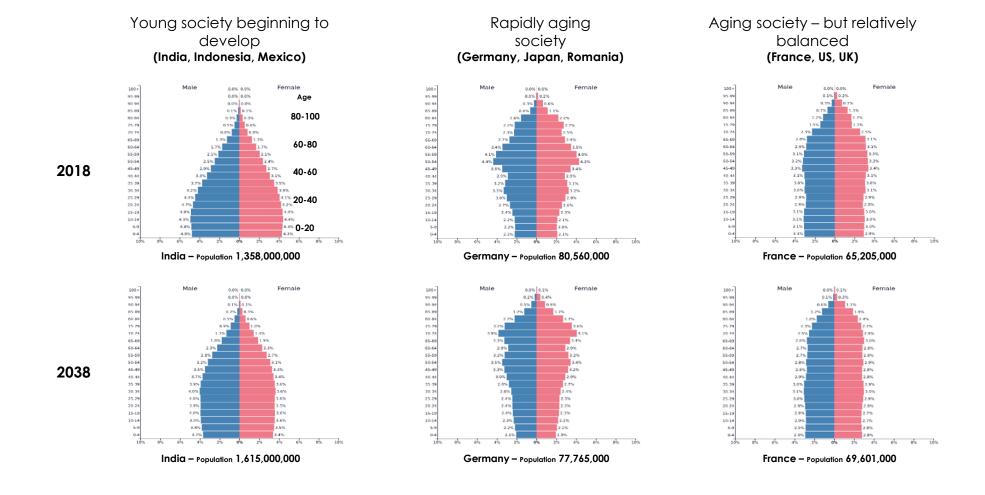

#### New Generational Workforce & Declining Populations

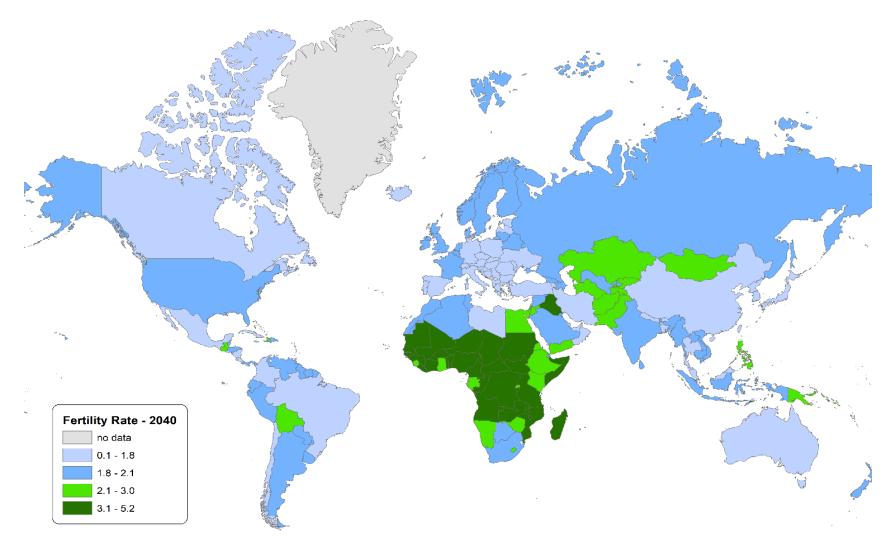

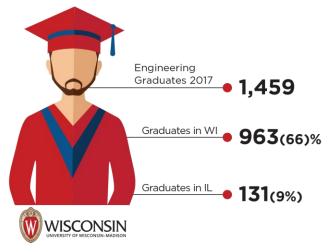

Engineering Wages and Talent Pipeline

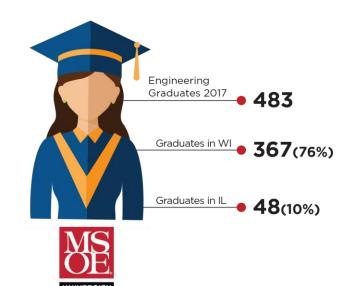


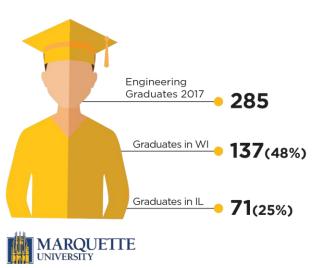

Nearly one in four Marquette graduates in 2017 moved to Illinois.









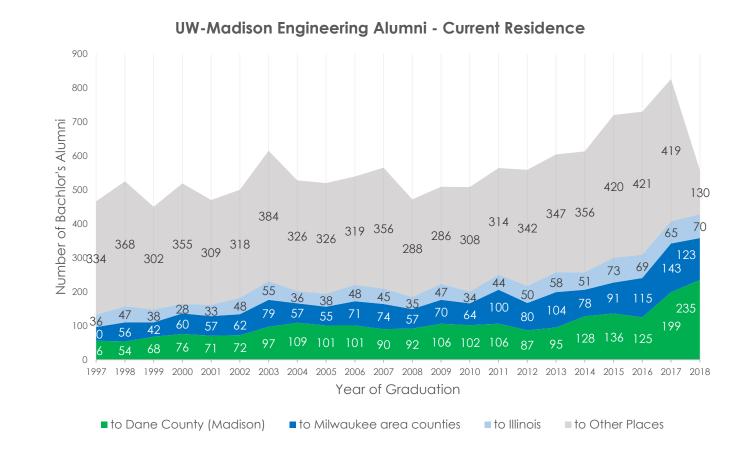

Data shows that more UW-Madison graduates are increasingly likely to stay in Madison or move to the Milwaukee area.



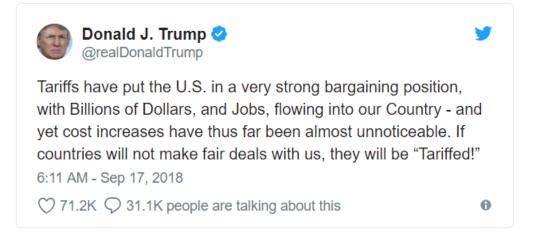

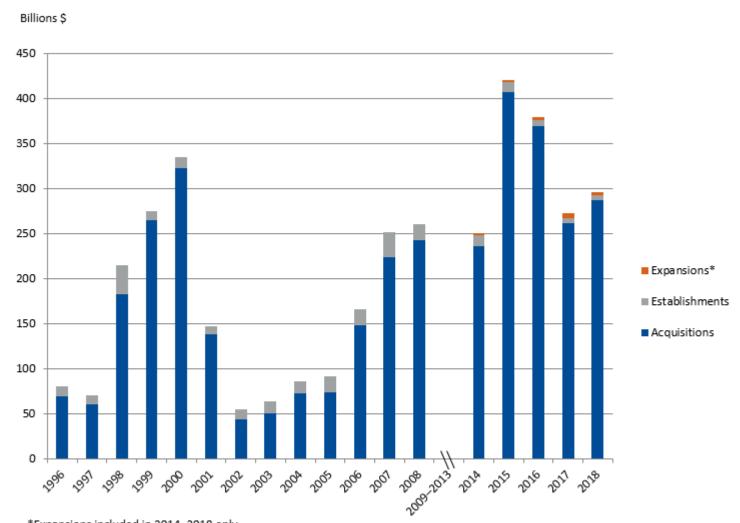
