






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


ASSEMBLY REPUBLICANS HAVE A 61-38 MAJORITY






VETO PROOF MAJORITY (66)?






SENATE REPUBLICANS HAVE A 21-12 MAJORITY


GOP GUBERNATORIAL CANDIDATE




GOV. EVERS JOB APPROVAL -3%









MOST RECENT POLLS ON GOV'S RACE WITHIN MOE





Cong. Tiffany was reelected with with 61% of the vote




Cong. Kind won re-election with 51.5% of vote; **not seeking re-election**

- Former Navy Seal, Leadership Consultant to Fortune 500 companies
- Lost to Cong. Kind by 2.7% in 2020.
- Trump won the 3rd CD both in 2016 and 2020. By 4.7% in 2020
- \$1.9 million cash-on-hand




State Sen. Brad Pfaff (D)

- Elected to State Senate in 2020
- Former DATCP Secretary-designee (not confirmed by Senate)
- Former long-time aid to Congressman Kind
- Won competitive Dem Primary




DEMOCRATS CONTROL US SENATE BECAUSE OF HARRIS












MANDELA BARNES FAVORABILITY









MOST RECENT POLLS ON U.S. SENATE RACE WITHIN MOE
