


Welcome to West Bend, Wisconsin

Vibrant Community


The City of West Bend is located in southeast Wisconsin, 30 minutes north of Milwaukee in Washington County—the heart of the Kettle Moraine.

Home to 32,000 residents, West Bend offers all the amenities of a large city yet has a warm and welcoming charm. It's easy to find opportunities to engage in the community through recreational activities, volunteering, and nonprofit organizations.











Situated on the Milwaukee River, historic downtown West Bend is a cultural hotspot. Featured cultural destinations include the West Bend Community Memorial Library, The Tower Heritage Center, The Bend Historic Theatre, Museum of Wisconsin Art, and Downtown Riverwalk.

Downtown restaurants, businesses, and shops thrive throughout the year. From May through October, streets are filled with the leading farmer's market in the state, outdoor festivals, and live music. The winter season is alive with ice sculptures, fat tire bike races and snow shoeing at Lac Lawrann Conservancy.
