Purpose

This year's course is scheduled for September 24-27 in Downtown Milwaukee. The CCIM courses or programs are designed to elevate commercial real estate professionals' careers to the next level. In awarding this scholarship, CCIM Wisconsin is seeking to elevate the success of its members and the industry.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Each application is reviewed by the CCIM Chapter Board of Directors based on the quality of the completed application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. If selected for the scholarship, individuals will be notified by email and the opportunity to be recognized in a CCIM newsletter.

Application Requirements

- Individuals must complete the application in its entirety to be considered and supply all information and forms as listed in the application.
 - Resume, endorsement from firm leader or CCIM board member and completed application form below.
- The completed application must be submitted to membership@carw.com for consideration.
- Application should be submitted no later than Friday, September 20th. Recipients will be notified by **Friday, September 27th**.

Eligibility Requirements

- The scholarship is exclusively given to a professional with under 5 years of experience.
- Applicants must reside in Wisconsin.
- Must be a current REALTOR® member in good standing for at least 6 months.
- Recipient of this scholarship should have a need for financial assistance.

Students will receive reimbursement in the allocated amount upon successfully completing the course.
